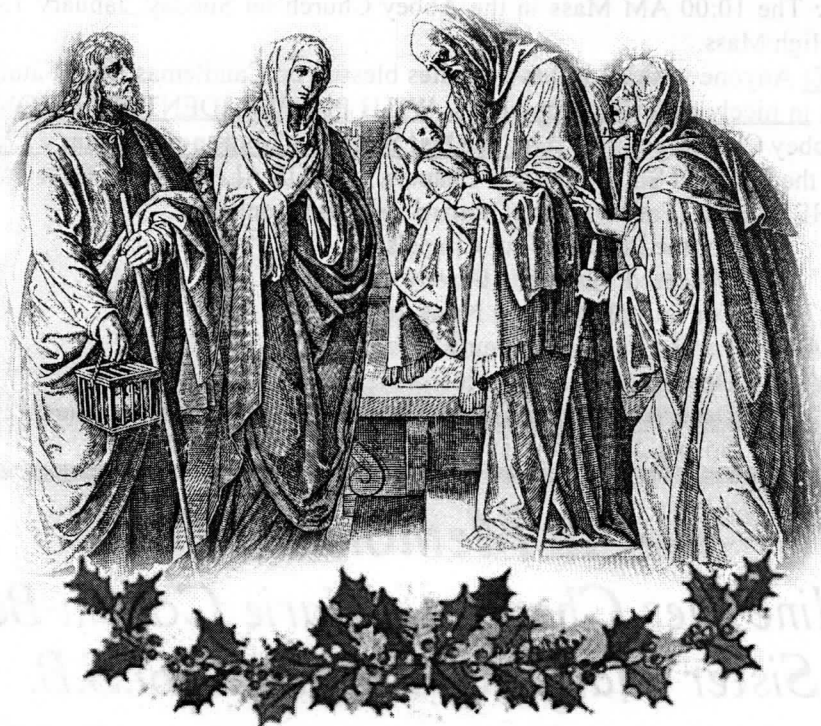

1. **CATECHISM CLASS: NO CATECHISM CLASS UNTIL NEXT SUNDAY, JANUARY 6, 2007.**
2. There WILL be 5:00 PM Sunday Vespers and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament this afternoon.
3. **Tuesday, January 1, 2008 (New Years Day), is the Feast of the Circumcision of Our Lord and is a Holyday of Obligation. Masses in the Abbey Church will be ONLY at 6:00 AM and 10:00 AM.**
4. Wednesday, January 2, 2008, is the Feast of the Holy Name of Jesus.
5. Thursday, January 3, 2008, is the first Thursday of January, with Holy Hour and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament in the Abbey Church from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM and from 3:30 PM to 4:30 PM.
6. Friday, January 4, 2008, is the First Friday of January, with Masses in the Abbey Church at 6:00 AM and 8:00 AM, and all-day Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament from 9:00 AM until 6:00 PM.
7. Saturday, January 5, 2008, is the Vigil of Epiphany. It is also the First Saturday of January, with Masses in the Abbey Church at 6:00 AM and 8:00 AM.
8. Next Sunday, January 6, 2008, is the Feast of the Epiphany of Our Lord. It is also the first Sunday of January. **Therefore there will be NO Mass at Saint Pius V Chapel in Birmingham next Sunday.** Epiphany Chalk will be blessed before the 6:00 AM Mass in the Abbey Church and the 10:45 AM Mass at Our Lady of Lourdes Chapel (in Montgomery) next Sunday morning, and distributed at all Masses the next two Sundays.
9. Also next Sunday, Father Prior will conduct the monthly meeting for our Oblates after the 10:00 AM Mass.
10. **EARLY NOTICE:** The 10:00 AM Mass in the Abbey Church on Sunday, January 13, the Feast of the Holy Family, will be a High Mass.
11. **EARLY NOTICE:** Anyone wishing to have candles blessed on Candlemas Day (Saturday, February 2, 2008), should bring them in nicely decorated containers, WITH PROPER IDENTIFICATION, and place them in the vestibule of the Abbey Church **no later than the last Sunday of January (January 27, 2008).**
12. Please pray for all the Sick and Shut-ins of our Chapels. LET US ALSO PRAY FOR EVERYONE.
