older and more mature souls. It is found in souls of education and erudition, who mindlessly commit themselves to an alternate way of dedicated wickedness. How absolutely wonderful it is when the prayer of some unknown soul and the grace of God together rescue a good intentioned, suffering soul and keep that soul well directed on the road of holiness and truth and salvation.

God spare us of improper prudence on the part of anybody! The properly constructed Catholic way of life does not paralyze good and healthy religious growth. True Catholic living is refreshing and wholesome. It is a life of true freedom. Parents and religious superiors must be persuaded that good example, family love, mutual trust, prudent family prayer, wholesome discipline consistently applied, humility, and a good religious atmosphere, all discretely promoted, are most effective in acquiring grace for the parents and superiors themselves, but especially for the children and those under their guidance. As they grow more experienced, they will take notice and will observe that a life where the Triune God and His most blessed Mother and the saints and angels play a major part, is after all a very normal, free, happy, and sanctifying life. They will come to the realization that that which is good and holy can be as delightful, even more so, and more fulfilling, than the unquestionably bad things found elsewhere. The family home and the religious community should be the safest and most heart warming of places. It is simply wonderful when goodness and happiness pervade the atmosphere. A family home or monastic religious community where there is peace and silence and love and prayer and joy is the very foyer of heaven. \Box
