To understand our own life, it is necessary for us to make a study of the LIFE OF CHRIST. But we must be careful not to allow ourselves to be taken by the EXTERNAL imaginative features, and fancy we are following in Christ's footsteps, when we are given to some practices of virtue, which bear some resemblance EXTERIORLY to those which He exhibited. It is true that to imitate Christ is to act as He acted, but IT IS EQUALLY TRUE that this is impossible unless we are trained TO THINK AS HE THOUGHT - expecially as regards the purpose of our life, in its relation to our own soul and to God. To make our efforts after sanctity issue in some real TRANSFORMATION of our souls, we should make a study of the INTERIOR DISPOSITIONS of our Lord, and grasp the broad principle according to which He worked out His Life's task. No attention to details can give such valuable results as the apprehending and accepting His whole mental attitude towards life itself. If we seize His mental outlook and if we try steadily, to adjust our own to it, we shall, in spite of, perhaps, constant lapses in practice and of repeated falls, still secure ourselves against that agonizing sense of failure which torments so many at the close of life!
