*Strictly speaking, according to the precise terminology of the true Church, Christ is neither physically nor spiritually present in the Eucharist. He is Sacramentally present, and sacramental presence is every bit as real as "physical" presence. There is a sacramental presence of Christ in the other sacraments also, but only in the Eucharist is this presence substantial, that is, the Host we now see, or receive, is truly Christ. He is not merely "in" the bread in some vague fashion.*

*! After the Consecration, there is no bread!*

*This is indeed, the mystery of faith.*
