A Word of Caution

It is grievously sinful to play video games that are even remotely of a pornographic impress or suggestion, and that in their clever presentation leave impure residues in the imagination of the young and the old which will last for a lifetime. Anything — at all — (jokes included) that tend to deteriorate the attitude of mind concerning the strict observance of the Sixth Commandment of God must be avoided. This must be attentively and accurately understood — under pain of sin! Call it what you will — there is no such as giving this matter a private relaxed interpretation and observance.

The very same approach must be taken concerning the OTHER NINE Commandments of God. It is equally sinful to play video games that in their nature and purpose form attitudes of mind contrary to the expressed Will of God. There is no justifiable argument that can be advanced in favor of such a dangerous pastime. Improper video games, literature and photographs are wrong. They are always improper and with much care must we examine the rules we use to justify all such improprieties.

Any inclusion of young children or young adults in the playing of such games is certainly iniquitous and unconscionable.
