1. Palm Sunday (March 19th.) is also the Feast of St. Joseph - celebration postponed. Holy Tuesday (March 21th) is the Feast of St. Benedict - celebration postponed. Prayers and private devotions to these two Saints of these days are otherwise very much in order and recommended.
2. Thursday of this week is HOLY THURSDAY; Friday is GOOD FRIDAY; and Saturday is HOLY SATURDAY. There will be NO MASS ON ANY OF THESE DAYS THIS YEAR! GOOD FRIDAY IS A DAY OF COMPLETE ABSTINENCE AND OF FAST UNDER PAIN OF SIN. Lent is over on Saturday at NOON.
3. All night vigil at St. Francis in Cullman - 8:00 P.M. -6:00 A.M. on Holy Thursday. Everyone is asked to pay some homage to the Blessed Sacrament during the time of the vigil.
4. THREE HOUR OBSERVATION 12:00 M to 3:00 P.M. on Good Friday. Stations of the Cross (outside -weather permitting) 2:45P.M. NO STATIONS OF THE CROSS IN THE EVENING.
