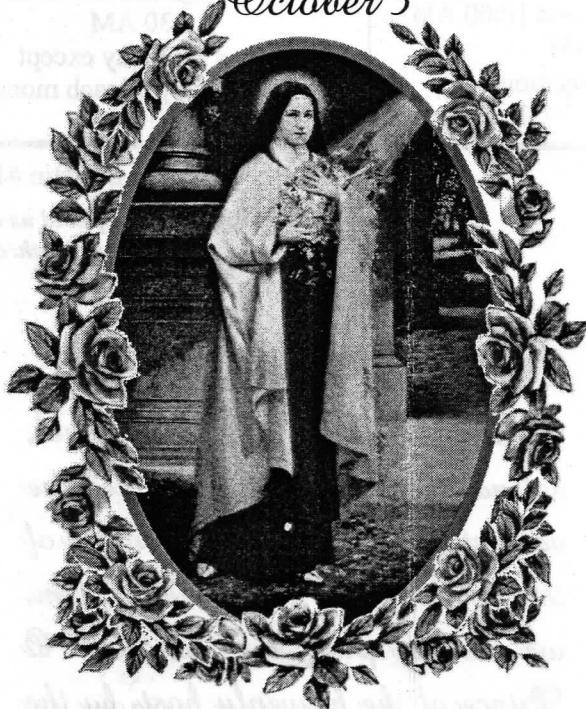


*Saint Theresa
of the Child Jesus*

O glorious Saint Therese, whom Almighty God has raised up to aid and counsel mankind, I implore your Miraculous Intercession. So powerful are you in obtaining every need of body and soul our Holy Mother Church proclaims you a "Prodigy of Miracles...the Greatest Saint of Modern Times." Henceforth, dear Little Flower, I will fulfill your plea "to be made known everywhere" and I will never cease to lead others to Jesus through you. Amen

1. There will be Catechism class after 10:00 AM Mass this morning.
2. Tuesday September 29, is the Feast of the Great Saint Michael the Archangel. He is the great defender of God. "Michael" means "Who is like unto God?" Let us pray to him for protection, and let us pray to him and ask him to bring God's holy grace to each of us.
3. Tuesday September 29, is also the Name day of our Father Michael. Please pray for him.
4. Wednesday September 30, is the Feast of Saint Jerome. He was born about 342 A.D. of a Christian family. An extraordinary man, he was indeed. Highly gifted intellectually, he was called by his Church for help. He answered and made a vow of celibacy. He withdrew and spent much time in the desert, praying in solitude and silence. Later the pope entrusted him with the enormous task of revising The New Testament, and many years later he translated the Old Testament from the original Hebrew on his own initiative. Incidentally, "Vulgate" simply means that the bible was translated into the "vulgar" language spoken by the people, and understood by them.
5. Thursday is the First Thursday of October. Holy Hour and Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament in the Abbey Church from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM and 3:30 PM to 4:30 PM.
6. Friday October 2, is the Feast of the Holy Guardian Angels. For us, the Holy Angels are the Patrons of the Benedictine Order, and now, of course, Christ the King Benedictine Monastery. Pray to them for protection. Friday is also First Friday of October, with Masses in the Abbey Church at 6:00 AM and 8:00 AM and all-day Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament from 10:00 AM until 5:00 PM.
7. Saturday October 3, is the Feast of Saint Theresa of the Child Jesus. Little needs to be said about Saint Theresa of the Child Jesus. Together with Saint Joseph, she is the patron of our Monastery Church. Ask her to help us grasp the meaning of becoming little children. Ask her how this is to be manifested in us...especially now as we travel in our highly technical and sophisticated existence.
8. Saturday October 3, is the First Saturday of October, with Masses in the Abbey Church at 6:00 AM and 8:00 AM.
9. There will be no Mass at Saint Pius V Chapel in Birmingham on October 25, the Feast of Christ the King.
10. Please pray for all the Sick and Shut-ins of our Chapels. LET US ALSO PRAY FOR EVERYONE.
