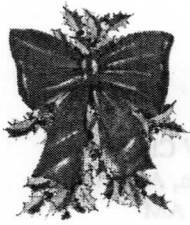

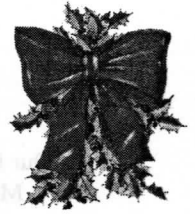

May you be blessed on this most beautiful of Feasts. Our hope is in Mary the Mother of Jesus Christ
Jesus, Mary, — I Love you — save Souls.

1. **Tuesday, December 7, is the Vigil of the Feast of the Immaculate Conception and is a day of complete abstinence and fast.**
2. There will be Catechism class after 10:00 AM Mass this morning.
3. Miss Elizabeth DiNardo will carry the baby Jesus and place Him in the crib at Midnight of Christmas.
4. Novena of the Immaculate Conception is now in progress
5. **Early notice: Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday, December 15, 17, and 18, are the Winter Ember Days, and are days of fast and abstinence. Meat may be eaten ONCE only on Wednesday and Saturday at the main meal.**
6. ADVENT is a time for SPIRITUAL RECOVERY AND RELIGIOUS AFFIRMATION. It should be an affirmation of our True Catholic way of believing and living. We must - - WE SIMPLY MUST - - redouble our efforts at living true Catholic Religious Life: "Sensus Catholicus," and we must dedicate ourselves to the task of creating a proper and correct atmosphere amongst Latin-Rite Roman Catholics. Every effort must be made to avoid all "home spun" catholicism. Our effort must be to be thoroughly and correctly Catholic, not Catholic mixed with something else - whatever that something else may be.
7. Please pray for all the Sick and Shut-ins of our Chapels. Pray for all people who are in need. Please pray for Abbot Leonard, O.S.B., Alfred Krebsbach and Frank Nash.
8. **Our Lady of Lourdes Chapel – Blessing of Bread** will take place today after Mass.
9. *Our Oblates of Our Lady of Lourdes Chapel will renew their oblation after Mass today.*
