There is in many writers a slightly false emphasis on the VIRTUE of poverty and lowliness. Poverty and lowliness of station are not good things in themselves. They are in their own nature indifferent, as are wealth and high station. The poor and lowly are not necessarily, by the very fact of being poor and lowly - virtuous; nor are the nobly born and the wealthy, through the accidental circumstances of their position in life, fatally vicious. It is true that our Lord dwells on the difficulty of the rich man's entry into the Kingdom of Heaven, but He does not state that the poor man enters therein with greater promptitude and facility. Our Blessed Lord makes it quite clear that the way to heaven is strait, narrow and difficult FOR ALL ALIKE. At the same time, He admits that, owing to men's proneness to pursue the advantages of station or fortune, riches and worldly position do actually prove a greater stumbling block than poverty to the pilgrim in his progress towards heaven.

On January 21, 1990, Venerable Brother Michael Sautner, O.S.B. will make his Simple Triennial Vows as a Benedictine Brother and Monk Brother will make his vows of POVERTY, CHASTITY, AND OBEDIENCE, STABILITY AND CONVERSION OF MORALS (conversion of life). This is no small thing for a young man to do in these our times. For most, this would cause a serious culture shock. Therefore, all of us should offer our best prayers for Brother Michael.
