## THE HOLY RULE OF OUR MOST HOLY FATHER BENEDICT

But, as we progress in our monastic life and in faith, our hearts shall be enlarged, and we shall run with unspeakable sweetness of love in the way of God's Commandments; so that, never abandoning His rule but perservering in His teaching in the monastery until death, we shall share by patience in the sufferings of Christ, that we may deserve to be partakers also of His Kingdom. Amen.
