In these our days, Faith is weak and quite erroneous. Therefore, we should ask our Blessed Saviour for the gift of the Faith of the Saints. We can safely say that we do have Faith, but is it truly a living, fiery Faith, fit to be the root and the spirit of enterprises to redeem souls? For to believe is not merely to have that common Faith in a vague, far off, impersonal Being. To believe is, above all to throw oneself into the arms of Jesus, the supreme revelation of the Father, to give all to Him, to live in Him: the Light that came down from Heaven to show us - sinful creatures - the way which leads to Him. Even here it is not enough to believe that He came down from heaven, and that He returned in His holy Ascension. We must also believe that HE REMAINED AND IS STILL LIVING AMONGST US, and because we believe this, we must live accordingly. To believe in Jesus is the secret of a close and divine brotherhood between Himself and ourselves. Our constant cry should be: "Lord, that I may see." Such a life would be the prelude to the vestibule of heaven, for the Beatific Vision consists in seeing and knowing everything in the light which is God. Let us contemplate and reproduce the life of faith which existed in Nazareth. Like Mary and Joseph let us learn how to labor, to suffer, to struggle in the company of Him Who continues to share our life. Any distance between Him and us arises from our want of Faith.
