If we wish to see God day by day, we must have the Faith to believe in God INCARNATE. To believe in God Incarnate is not merely to believe that under the human vesture is the Godhead, but to believe as STRONGLY THAT THIS HUMAN VESTURE, IN ALL ITS PARTICULARS, BELONGS TO AND IS THE APT AND FITTING CLOTHING OF THE DIVINE. We must believe that if God the Son is to be discovered on earth by men (IN THIS OUR DAY), He is to be found clothed in ALL the elements of His Humanity and in ALL the circumstances of His Humanity and ALL the conditions of His Humanity. We must believe also that God literally reveals Himself to us IN THE THOUGHTS, JUDGEMENTS, DOINGS AND ENDURING OF THE SACRED HUMANITY OF JESUS CHRIST. We must believe that the life of Jesus amongst men is the DIVINE WAY OF LIVING ON EARTH. To believe in God Incarnate is not merely to accept the Divinity of Jesus Christ; it is to accept His Humanity ALSO: it is not merely to believe in His Godhead, but to believe in His Manhood, too! We must believe that Christ is divine in the way God is divine, and we must believe as firmly that He is human in the way men should be human. To accept Him as human is not merely to accept Him as man - (that He had a body and a soul like ours) - but it is to accept and to subscribe to ALL his views on life on earth and His ENTIRE teaching on HUMAN VALUES. It is not only to believe in the reality of God's human life, it is to hold firmly that the human life of God (IN THE PERSON OF JESUS CHRIST) is the ONLY true human life - or perhaps, better: - - - the only life that is truly human!
