Why do we observe Lent? The basic reason is that during the Lenten Season the Cross of Christ looms as the most significant factor of our Salvation. It brings before us vividly the picture of the Sacrifice and Suffering of the INNOCENT ONE - Christ offering Himself on the Cross for us and for all Mankind. Lent also provides a period of evaluation to stop and ask: "What is happening to me as a person?" Am I becoming more proud; self satisfied with what I have, or know; uncharitable; given more to the demands of the body; domineering; given more to overdrinking or overeating; cursing; selfish; given to anger; more slothful; more envious and jealous; crude or impressed with my own importance????? What has happened to my prayer life? Why do I pray? Do I give any time to the study of my religious beliefs and practices? IS GOD THE CENTER OF ALL I DO??? Unless we take a serious inventory of ourselves, we can easily drift into a pattern of living that is characterized by the above evils. Lent is also a period of SPIRITUAL NOURISHMENT. Jesus said: "Come unto Me and I will refresh you." During Lent, the Church calls unto her children - Come, receive the Sacrament of Penance, make a good Confession; Listen to the Word of God as preached to you; say more and better prayers; receive Holy Communion at Mass; BE MORE REGULAR ABOUT ATTENDING HOLY MASS and be REFRESHED BY THE REFRESHMENT THAT COMES ONLY FROM JESUS CHRIST!!!
