For the FIRST TIME in its history, the Monastery of Christ the King will observe TENEBRAE this year. Tenebrae is a solemn recitation of the Holy Divine Office by the Monks, in which the Lamentations of Jeremiah are sung in a very ancient and solemn tone. There are twelve psalms which are recited by the monks, at the end of each psalm a candle is extinguished, and as the office proceeds, all candles are estinguished except one, the Light which is Christ finally disappears and DARKNESS (Tenebrae) comes about.
