The Holy Eucharist is the FOUNDATION (corner stone if you will) of our Faith. Our Divine Savior wishes to remain with us under the insignificant appearance of bread, so that everything we do toward uniting ourselves to Him should be a pure act of MOST MERITORIOUS FAITH. Our faith is only then an act of homage to the Divine Majesty and a meritorious act of adoration when it is based on the authority of Divine Revelation. Everything concerning the Blessed Sacrament is SHROUDED IN DEEP MYSTERY. No created spirit, not even the seraphim or cherubim, is capable of penetrating the mystery which hovers about this sublime Sacrament. Our reason is suspended before this unsolved problem; our senses protest against a doctrine which is beyond their sphere. Natural knowledge fails in this case. Here avails only humble faith in the well known words of our Blessed Lord. If, then, a man establishes or founds his unshaken faith solely on the well known words of Christ, that faith is, in truth, supernatural - - a faith such as God expects from him. Such faith is unyielding; it stands the test of the cornerstone which Christ has left to us in the Most Blessed Sacrament. We may say in all truth that our zeal and fervor toward the Most Blessed Sacrament is a reliable barometer of our whole spiritual life. The true Christian - - the reliable Catholic - - is known by his faith in the Blessed Sacrament.

On these days we should implore God to deliver us from all evil, to bestow peace to the world, bless our crops, bless all the suffering and dying in the world, keep us from all harm and danger and sickness, bless the members of our families, and to PRESERVE TRUTH AND HOLINESS IN OUR HOLY CHURCH. Let us pray that the leaders of the Church receive Grace sufficient to call them back to the TRUTH - THE UNCHANGING TRUTH - OF CHRIST.
3. On the Feast of the Holy Ghost, please pray that He will inspire good and holy men to become good and holy priests and brothers of our Monastery. Pray, also, that the Holy Ghost will EVER protect the Monks of our Monastery from the snares of the devil, and that they WILL ALWAYS BE STRONG IN THE FAITH: "FORTES IN FIDE"!!!!
