You can go on saying 'NOT YET' for such a long time that you forget what it was that you prayed for. In the same way you can go on saying, ' I can't bring myself to take it on,' for so long a time that YOU COME IN THE END TO BELIEVE THAT HOLINESS IS TOO TOUGH AND NOT FOR YOU. When this happens, of course you cease to FEEL the urge to take it on. So becoming holy has to be NOW, and it has to be BY GOD'S GRACE, FOR ONLY IN THAT CAN WE DO ALL THINGS. THE STRENGTH COMES FROM GOD!!!
