There is little - if anything - in our general surroundings that is of direct help to incite us or to help us to find God. In fact the general effect of our modern environment is not merely negative; it has even a positive tendency to lead us away from God. This it does not so much by being against God, but rather by leaving Him out. He is simply being ignored. Our children will not be aware of His existence, and will consequently be quite indifferent to any moral values. Like it or not, we live in fact in a pagan - if not heathen - civilization, and the strong modernist elements found today in the mainstream church of Rome is failing in its responsibility. The pagan cult no longer has a strong opponent in the Roman Catholic Christian Cult, and is, therefore, making itself seen where it has no business being seen. The remnants of Christian ideals that are still found in common opinion, and which still express themselves in common practice are divorced from their dogmatic foundation of real fact and true faith - - they are based mainly on sentiment, emotion and expediency - and have become over the years twisted quite out of recognition. As guiding ideals, they rather tend to mislead, and Catholic pulpits, by their silence, have provided a proper medium, suited to the incubation of every sort of viral evil.
