About confession there is one point that is very important. Sorrow for sins is an ESSENTIAL condition for a valid reception of the Sacrament. This sorrow must extend to all the mortal sins of which we have been guilty. If there are no mortal sins, we must be truly sorry for at least some of the venial sins confessed. Otherwise the sacrament is not balid. Now sorrow implies a SINCERE PURPOSE AND DECISION to avoid sin in the future, and it is important to make sure that we have such a purpose in regard to at least some of the venial sins confessed when there are no mortal sins. To make certain there is proper matter for absolution it is always advisable to INCLUDE SOME SINS OF THE PAST FOR WHICH WE ARE CERTAINLY SORRY and which we are determined to avoid in the future. Such a practice saves our confession from being invalid should it consist only of routine venial sins for which
