Some errors become evident when a careful look is given to the attitudes which prompt acts of charity between one and another. Such a look, of course, requires first of all, a proper interpretation of human love. It must be understood that in one's relation with another, there are varying degrees of human love. There is the love which exists between husband and wife; there is the love which exists between two about to be married; there is the love that exists between good and true friends; and there is the love that is so very necessary in religious communities-- the love that bonds the various members into one religious body. There are times, however, when self-will and an obstinate refusal to accomodate oneself to the will of one's partner or friend, or religious brother or sister, indicate an obvious lack of love. True and genuine love cannot divide itself in its own order; it must have its profound need satisfied by the one who is the object (or objects) of its affection. The waywardness of weakness and the faults of frailty can be forgiven by love, precisely because it is love. But there is one thing that love, precisely because it is love, finds most difficult to forgive. There is one thing that causes love, because it is so deep a love, intense anguish; there is one thing which REPELS love and casts it down and shatters it completely, like a crystal bowl thrown against a rock, and that is SELF-SUFFICIENCY! Love is by nature dependent, and calls for dependence. Love wants to GIVE - - and NOTHING CAN BE GIVEN TO THE SELF-SUFFICIENT!
