3. Confessions will be heard before Masses on Sunday. However, there will be no confessions before the 10:00 A.M. Profession Mass.
4. Please pray for all the sick and shut-ins of our chapels, especially remembering our Brother Al Sachs.
5. Please pray for the successful construction of our Abbey Church - a MONASTIC CHURCH - one to be used by Monks in their daily prayer and liturgical observances. Everyone must try to understand that this church is not intended to be a parochial church, and that even the architecture of it shall express its purpose. Before the chaotic conditions found both in the world AND IN THE CHURCH, can be corrected, we must all return to prayer, and the best and most significant place for prayer is in THE HOLY MONASTIC INSTITUTIONS.
