Insistence on overemphasizing the MEAL aspect of the Mass is the error made by so many of our "progressive" liturgists and theologians. The Mass is not a "HOLY MEAL", or a "SACRED BANQUET". As the Council of Trent made clear while refuting reformers who denied the ministerial priesthood, and thus the nature of the Mass as a sacrifice, the Mass is a re-presentation of the SACRIFICE of the Cross in an unbloody manner. This concept was reiterated in Vatican Council's II Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy. While the Mass is NOT a holy meal, it does contain a holy meal. The meal aspect of the Mass is Holy Communion.

This is clearly shown in the Novus Ordo of Pope Paul VI when he sanctioned two separate circumstances for Mass: ONE WITH A CONGREGATION AND ONE WITHOUT A CONGREGATION. In other words, you do not need a community or an assembly or a congregation present to offer a Mass. While it is laudatory for those present at Mass to receive Communion, for a Mass to be valid, only the priest- celebrant must receive Holy Communion. This same teaching is to be found in the Tradition of the Church.
