



CEREMONY FOR THE BLESSING OF HOUSES AND ALL PLACES FEAST OF THE EPIPHANY OF JESUS CHRIST.

BLESSING OF CHALK:

(Instruction: Chalk is blessed on the Altar, before Holy Mass begins. It will not be distributed by the priest, but can only be obtained by a member of the Family who must go up to the Altar, after Mass, and taking it. The Father of the Family will later use it to inscribe the initials of the Three Wise Men: Gaspar, Melchior and Balthazar, and the current year over the main door (and any other doors) of the home. This inscription should remain over the doors throughout the year.)

PASTOR: - Opening Antiphon: Behold, the Lord the ruler is come; and the kingdom is in His Hand, and power, and dominion.

O God, with your judgement endow the king, and with your justice, the king's son. Glory be to the Father. Behold, the Lord.

Antiphonal Prayer:

y. All nations shall serve Him.

R. All nations shall serve Him.

y. Nations shall walk by Your light, and kings by Your shining radiance.

R. All nations shall serve Him.

y. All from Saba shall come, bringing gold and frankincense, and proclaiming the praises of the Lord.

(Conducted by the Father, or, in his absence, by the Mother).
