LENT

The <u>WAY OF THE CROSS</u> always begins with the astounding indicent which we have come to take so much for granted: Jesus being condemned to die on the cross. No matter how often we go around the Stations, or meditate on the terrible crime of the deicide, we are apt to overlook two very important considerations.



The first of these is the fact that Jesus was actually condemned to die long before the day when the vacillating Pilate washed his hands and turned his eyes away from the Man whom he knew to be innocent. It was humanity in its deliberate turning from God's plan that condemned Christ to death. The second point we overlook in this great mystery is the fact that Christ does not go alone to Calvary. Adam's sin precipitated death upon a deathless world at that time and so brought it about in the divine decree that the Son of God must die if man were ever to enter heaven. Adam gave to all his sons the seeds of death.
