LENT

Christ died a criminal's death, almost alone, in dire poverty, and was laid in a borrowed tomb. His followers had fled, the kingdom He preached had not materialized, the chief of his apostles denied Him, one of his apostles handed Him over to those who had Him put to death, His very words seemed to be proved untrue by His falling into the hands of the executioners. Rejected, scourged, and crucified by the very people He had brought back to life, whom He had cured, whom He had fed in wonderful ways, and - at the moment of His death He was as near to failure, humanly speaking, as man can possibly be. Who at that moment would have dared to compare His importance with that of the great Caesar whose word swayed a continent, the Caesar whose "friends" had condemned Him to death? Yet the years tell a different tale. Who today would sacrifice home and friends and all earthly love, for the love of an Augustus Caesar? The very idea is ridiculous. Yet every Christian man, woman and child, worthy of the name Christian bears testimony that "the loveliness of His beauty" surpasses the power of Caesar and outlives the pomp of Rome.
