As a matter of fact, I have taken much away from myself. All that I have succeeded in doing is to assemble together into an unreal person the separate qualities which I admire in others. I have made of myself a "carbon" copy of other people. If instead I were to take whatever qualities I have got, and let them make up the person whom God has created - the person whom God would like for me to be - I would have something true at the end of it all. This way I might probably not appear, either to myself or to other people around me as much of a hero, or as much of a champion, but, at least I would be true to myself and to my God Who made me according to His own likes and desires! This way it would be much better for me, for I will be giving pleasure to my Maker and my God, rather than to my admirers.

To live the part that exists only in my own imagination is not to live at all. It is a borrowed life! Worse yet - it is not even being borrowed from God Who is the Author of Life. It is being borrowed from fiction.
