THE ADVENT WREATH: The Advent Wreath is the most popular of the Advent customs. The Wreath has been handed down to us by way of its German origin. It is made of evergreens, bound to a circle of wire. It was taken, so we are told, from the pagan fire wheel - and now represents the cycle of thousands of years from Adam to Christ during which the world awaited the coming of a Redeemer. It also represents the cycle of years since then that we have been awaiting His second and final coming in glory. It bears four candles, equally spaced, three purple ones and to be lighted on the three "penitential" Sundays, and one rose-colored one for Gaudete Sunday - the joyful Sunday in Advent. Any kind of Christmas wreath such as those hung in windows may be used. It may be set on a kitchen or dining room table, or on an end table in the living room - any place in the home will do: and place where the family can easily assemble to give honor and praise to God.
