1) HISTORICAL RECORD: "THAT IN ALL THINGS GOD MAY BE GLORIFIED" "U. I. O. G. D."

The First Mass to be said in the New Abbey Church of Christ the King Abbey was said on the Vigil of Christmas: December 24, 1994. This was a Mass said privately and exclusively for the Monks of Christ the King Abbey.

The First Mass to be said publicly in the New Abbey Church of Christ the King Abbey was said at Midnight for the Feast of Christmas: December 25, 1994.

The Monks of the Abbey began reciting the Divine Office in the New Abbey Church on the evening of December 23, 1994, and the Office of Vespers for the Vigil of Christmas was recited.
