But the Eternal Church has remained and will continue to remain - to the chagrin of all would-be conquerors - even though it exists in a very

small and impoverished state.

Reduced in number that we are, we have, nevertheless, inherited the responsibilities of all the popes and saints beck to St. Peter himself. Our greatest single duty and purpose as dedicated traditionalist priests and people is to preserve the continuity of the centuries, and the existence of a Catholic and holy church. Every care must be taken that all concerned understand that the "continuity of the centuries" is necessarily established in the simple and never changing Faith of the people whose will is good. The contiuity is perilously maintained, if "things", even though they be treasures, are used as the focal point around which holy Tradiition is maintained.
