DOMINICA PENTECOSTES

- 1. SUNDAY, JUNE 4, 1995 - N E X T S U N D A Y is the Feast of the Holy Ghost - Pentecost Sunday, and is a Feast of the greatest importance. In importance, it is equal to that of the Feast of Easter, the two being of the highest rank in our church year. Pentecost is a day that we should pray most specially to the Holy Ghost, and ask Him to enlighten the darkness of our beliefs and our Faith.
