# DOMINICA PENTECOSTES

1. SUNDAY, JUNE 4, 1995 - - - N E X T S U N D A Y is the Feast of the Holy Ghost - - Pentecost Sunday, and is a Feast of the greatest importance. In importance, it is equal to that of the Feast of Easter, the two being of the highest rank in our church year. Pentecost is a day that we should pray most specially to the Holy Ghost, and ask Him to enlighten the darkness of our beliefs and our Faith. Unless and until the Holy Ghost enlighten us, every Truth will be beyond our understanding and comprehension. Unfortunately, since it is observed this year on the first Sunday of June, it will be impossible to celebrate Mass in all the chapels. Therefore, everyone is urged to spend a sufficient amount of time in prayer and meditation on that most wonderful of days. Ask the Holy Ghost to inspire every one of us, and to place within the hearts and minds of each of us a profound love for peace, serenity, and a humble love of God. Ask Him to teach us the true value of UNITY!!!!!!!
2. Next Sunday, June 4, 1995 (Pentecost Sunday) is the First Sunday of June. Therefore, there will be no 9:30 A.M. Mass at St. Pius Chapel in Birmingham, and no 12:30 P.M. Mass at St. Pius Chapel in Cullman.
3. Saturday, June 3, 1995 is the VIGIL OF PENTECOST, and is a day of Fast and partial Abstinence.
4. Wednesday, Friday and Saturday of Pentecost Week - June 7, 9, and 10, are Ember days and are days of Fast and partial Abstinence, Friday being total abstinence.
5. Sunday, June 11, 1995 is the FEAST OF THE MOST BLESSED TRINITY, and is the FINAL day for the performance of one's Easter Duty.
