4. Today is the <u>SUNDAY WITHIN THE OCTAVE OF CORPUS CHRISTI</u>. Do not forget your ACTS OF REPARATION to the Most Blessed Eucharist.

When you read holy books, seek spiritual consolation and profit and the love of God, not curiosity, not superfluous understanding and knowledge, not neatness and elegance of words; for the Kingdom of God is not in elegance of speech but in holiness of life. Be not troubled if many of the good things you hear or read slip out of your memory. Your chief profit consists, not in committing the word of doctrine to memory, but rather that the effects of the doctrine and words remain in you, namely: that because of the doctrine you achieve internal purity and a ready mind to fulfill the commandments of God.
