Since practically all traditionalists affirm that they are formally separated from the authority of the hierarchical Roman Church ("not in union with Rome") no individual traditionalist, or any organized group of traditionalists, is qualified with absolute certitude to state that such and such a person is formally a heretic or not a member of the Church. Neither are the traditionalists qualified to impose the laws of the Church upon each other. The following quotation from a paper written by the late Bishop Guerard de Laurier, O.P. is very significant on this point. Before he became a bishop, Father de Laurier taught at the seminary located at Econ. Later he was consecrated a bishop by Archbishop Thuc. Father de Laurier was a noted Canon Lawyer and Theologian.

"Those who claim the right to impose such affirmations with absolute certitude USURP AUTHORITY. It is impossible to have, with regard to these issues, absolute certitude, or even moral certitude (to do so would be to elevate one's immediate impressions to the LEVEL OF A LAW). Even though they would defend the Church, their witness with regard to ecclesiastical realities is deprived of any reality."
