Instead of sinking into a mood of despair and self-pity, such a person says simply, 'This has turned out wrong, and everything is in a mess, and I have no idea how it is going to be put right, but I can still count absolutely on the Providence of God.' However, there is one very important thing to remember at this point. It can be - not only possible but also many times probable - - that such a person can abuse the virtue of hope and presume on the Providence of God and he goes merrily on a

completely reckless way of life. Such persons can be so lacking in plain common sense and prudence, that they make the virtue of hope the excuse for their avoidable mistakes and mismanagement. Such an attitude borders dangerously on predestination.
