They do two things: on the one side they keep clear of anything that they think is going to get in the way of grace, and on the other they head DIRECTLY for our Lord. Their only concern is the glory of God not their own personal satisfaction. So it is not that the saints do particularly ?'saintly'? things (like fierce penances, whole nights spent on their knees, long fasts, raptures in prayer, miracles, prophecies, visions); rather it is more that they do all things IN A PARTICULARLY SAINTLY WAY - in exactly the way they feel God wishes from them - the little things. To them the only thing in the world that matters is God's Will, They know that by doing God's will as perfectly as they can they are imitating our Lord, Our service of God does not depend upon how we feel -(emotionalism) - - rather it depends upon how God looks at it. It should not be our purpose to do those things that would earn us the title of 'saint'.
