The PALM CROSSES, which have been blessed Three Times - (1) Palm Sunday, (2) The Feast of St. Peter the Martyr, (3) Feast of the Finding of the True Cross - and which have been blessed for our protection from all evil - are available today. Please approach the place where the little Crosses are located, and take one or more. Place them around and about your homes: in FAITH AND HOPE in the Power of God, Himself.
