The usual formula of prayers is: 6 Our Fathers, 6 Hail Mary's and 6 Glory be's. In order that one gain the indulgence, one must pray according to the Intention of the Supreme Pontiff and receive the

Sacraments on All Saint's Day or on All Soul's Day.
