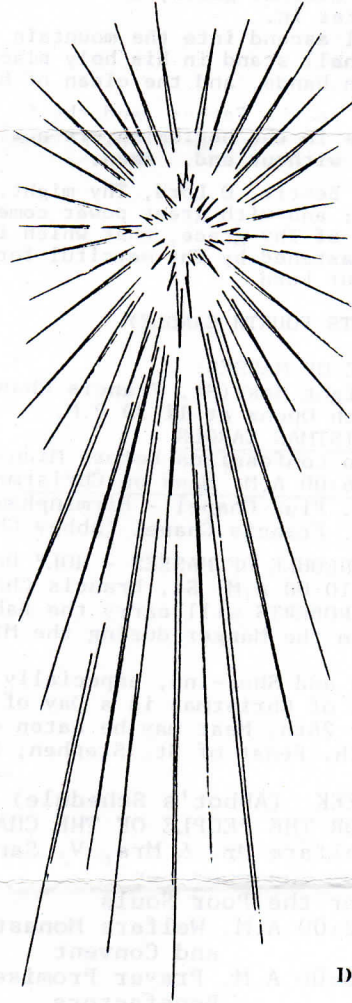

with joy.*



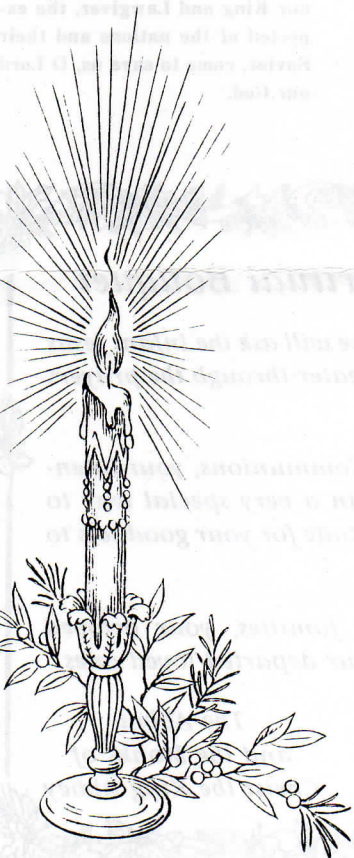
*If we wish to see God

gether with man. It is to believe that this human*

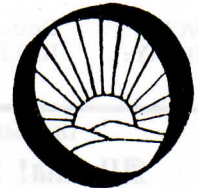
*vesture, IN ALL ITS
