Visitors from other places are accustomed to a more relaxed affair, but we must never fail to teach - by our example - that a venerable and solemn posture is always proper when dealing with things that pertain to God. We must never fail to maintain & observe a proper dress code when in attendance at Holy Mass: the awesome presence of God demands this.
