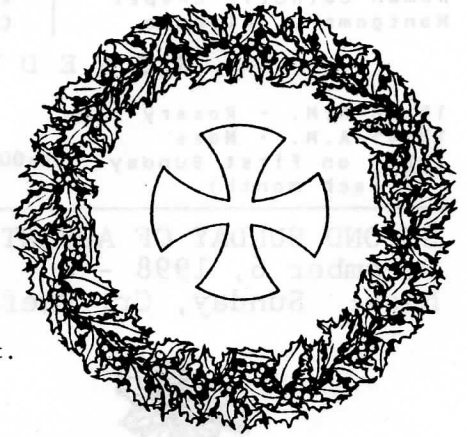


Second Sunday in Advent

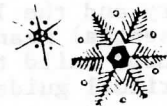
THE MASS must be

He was always cheerful and never felt sorry for himself, and was a source of great edification to all who had the good fortune of coming into contact with him. The usual five Masses will be offered for the repose of Father Paschal's Soul here at Christ the King Abbey. Please pray for him, and for those who extended kindnesses and charity to him and who helped him carry his very heavy burden.
