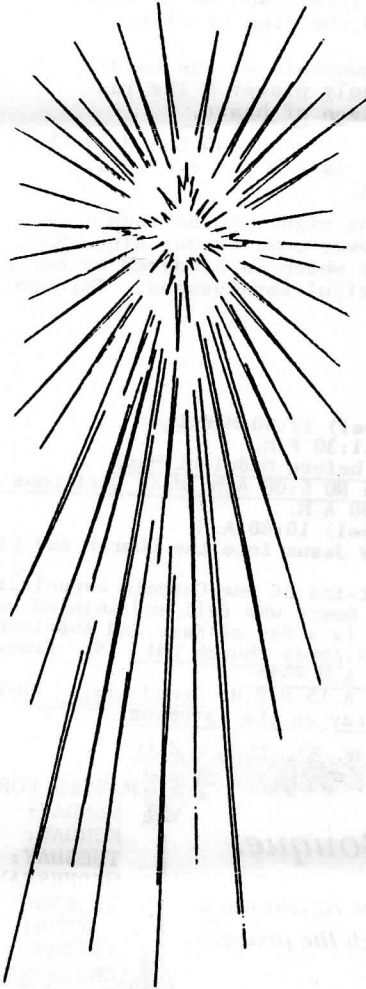

ADVENT



If we wish to see God day after day, our faith must be of a better quality than we ordinarily give proof of; our understanding of Christ must be based upon the reality that existed in Him. Our constant prayer should be for an increase of Faith.

It is to believe that if God the Son is to be discovered on earth by men, He is to be found clothed in all the elements of His Humanity and in all the circumstances of His Humanity and in all the conditions of His Humanity, and in all of the outlooks, concerns, and necessities of His Humanity.

It is to believe that the life of Jesus Christ on Earth amongst men is the Divine Way of Man's Living on Earth.
