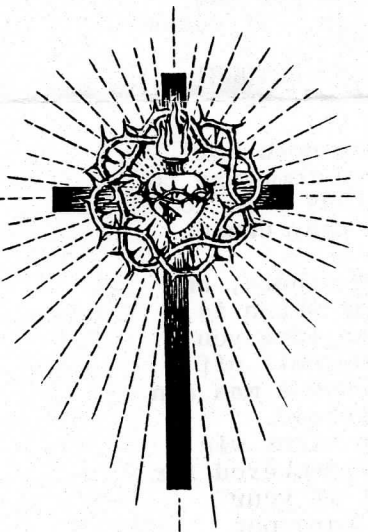


Let Us Go To Follow Him . . .

1. Stations of the Cross and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament every Friday during Lent at 7:00 P.M. Please make every effort to attend this most worthwhile service.

3. Ashes will be distributed after all the Masses today. After Mass please approach the Communion Railing and receive the Blessed Ashes.
Help yourselves to the small packets of Ashes. USE THEM! Sprinkle around your house, or garden or wherever. Bring the Blessing of the Church into your home and garden.
4. On Saturday morning, February 13, 1999, Reverend Father Mark Mages, O.S.B. died peacefully in the Lord. Father Mark, was truly a good priest, and a charitable man - a Man of God - to be sure. His piety was real, and his devotion was genuine. Please pray for Father Mark, that God will give him quick entrance to his eternal reward.

5. Wednesday, Friday and Saturday of this week are Ember Days and are days of Fast and Abstinence. Meat may be eaten once on Wednesday and Saturday - at the main meal.
6. Wednesday, February 24, 1999 is the Feast of St. Matthias.
7. Be reminded to use the Sacrament of Penance. The Sacrament of Penance is a very important Sacrament. It is not up to the individual to determine its proper use. It must be used and by all.
8. During Lent please pray for good and holy and persevering vocations to the Monastery and the Convent. We need vocations and vocations that can and will pray that God will be persuaded to come to the aid of suffering mankind.
