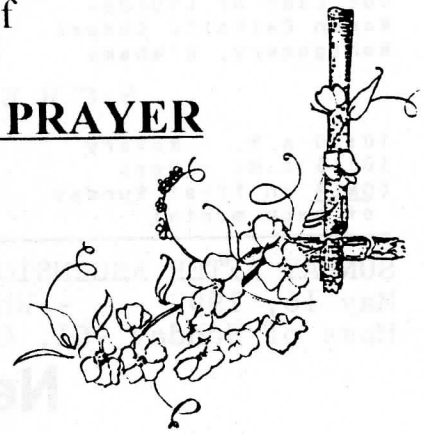
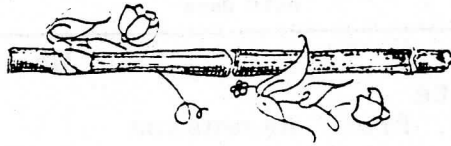
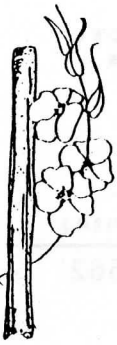


Let us prepare for the coming of

1. Early preparation for the Feast of CORPUS CHRISTI . The Feast of Corpus Christi takes place on Thursday, June 3, 1999.
