### *A Lecture From An Anonymous Source*

*The Lord has given to every man his work. It is his business to do it, and the devil's business to hinder him if he can. So sure as God has given you a work to do, Satan will try to hinder you. He may present other things more promising. He may allure you by worldly prospects, he may assault you with slander, torment you with false accusations.*

*Keep about your work. Do not flinch because the lion roars; do not stop to stone the devil's dogs; do not fool away your time chasing the devil's rabbits. Do your work. Let liars be - let liars lie; let sectarians quarrel, let corporation resolve, let editors publish, let the devil do his worst; but see to it that nothing hinders you from fulfilling the work that God has given to you.*

*Keep about your work. Let your aim be as steady as a star. Let the world brawl and bubble, you may be assaulted, wronged, insulted, slandered, wounded and rejected; you may be abused by foes forsaken by friends and despised and rejected by men, but see to it with steadfast determination, with unfaltering zeal, that you pursue the great purpose of your life and object of your being, until at last you can say:*

*"I have finished the work which You gave me to do,  
I have kept the Faith."*
