

The belief or the faith or the wishes of the people present in no way effects Transubstantiation. If the priest fails to fulfill ALL of the requirements in this matter, not bringing about Transubstantiation, the Faith of the people present will not take up where the priest left off. If the priest fails to Consecrate, the people receive no more than ordinary bread for communion, even if they believe otherwise. This has been the official teaching, the constant and habitual and ageless teaching of our Catholic Religion. Belief in the Eucharist is basic Catholic doctrine. The question must be asked: "If one does not believe in the Eucharist, thinking it to be a symbolic action, is such a one properly called Catholic?"

Present day erroneous teaching concerning the matter of the Transubstantiation, has brought about most serious deviations in Catholic Worship, Catholic Life Experience, Catholic Observance, and Catholic Thought. Catholic Thought demands CORRECT and EXACT understanding and belief in this fundamental Catholic teaching. It is not open to opinion, interpretation or adaptation - no matter who the teacher may be. □
