## **CATHOLIC EXPERIENCE - - HOLY EUCHARIST**

Recent official documents, if very carefully studied, will lead any mentally honest and sober thinking Catholic - even one with underdeveloped theological experience - to ponder, and to wonder and to ask quetsions. Not until the protestants appeared on the scene, the Blessedness of the Eucharist remained untarnished for centuries, and for centuries even to recent years, dedicated popes, bishops and priests protected it, even at the cost of their lives. And the presiding officer who presides at the head table looks about to see that EVERYBODY gets plenty to eat and drink. It is a joyful worship event!
