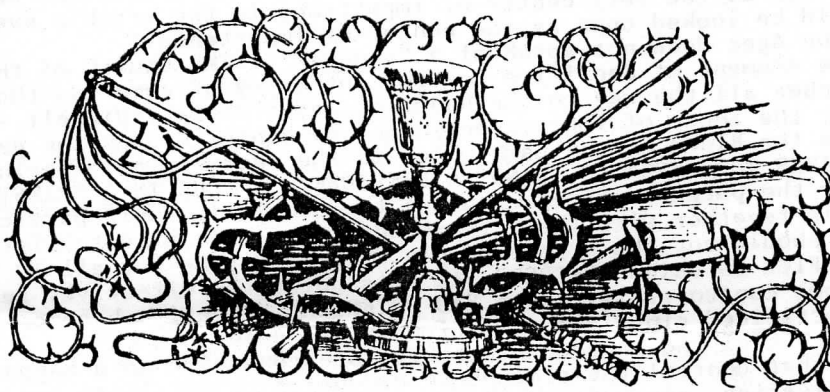


1. Next Sunday is the First Sunday of April. Therefore, there will be no 9:30 A.M. Mass at St. Pius V Chapel in Birmingham.
