1. Today is the Glorious Feast of THE MOST HOLY TRINITY - Father, Son and Holy Spirit and truly a Most important occasion. Let us not fail to express ourselves most earnestly to the Holy Trinity. THE ATHANASIAN CREED will be recited by all at the 10:00 A.M. Mass at the Abbey Church and at the 9:30 A.M. Mass at St. Pius V Chapel.
2. The Feast of CORPUS CHRISTI takes place on Thursday, June 22, 2000 A.D.. On that day there will be two masses in the Abbey Church: 6:00 A.M. and 8:00 A.M. The solemn observance of the Feast of Corpus Christ will take place NEXT Sunday - June 25, 2000. Of all times, this year - the First year of the NEW MILLENNIUM - it is imperative that serious acts of reparation be made to Our Blessed Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. The Blessed Sacrament is being profaned in all quarters - and even by those who were sent to protect it from profanation!. For us it is a matter of grave obligation to do something about the sacrilege, even if the inconvenience is serious and difficult. Every precaution must be taken lest perhaps our prayer - our reparation - our penance - our mortification be lacking in genuineness of heart and generosity of soul. If we fail, then we will be adding to the great sacrilege! and our accounting will be all the greater!

7. Sunday, July 2, 2000 is the First Sunday of July, therefore, there will be no 9:30 A.M. Mass at St. Pius V. Chapel in Birmingham.
8. Saturday, July 1, 200 is the FEast of the Most Precious Blood of Jesus, and is ALSO, the First Saturday of July. Masses in the Abbey Church are at 6:00 A.M. and 8:00 A.M.
9. Friday, July 7, 2000 is the First Friday of July. Mass are at 6:00 A.M. and 8:00 A.M.
10. Friday, June 30, 2000 is the Wonderful Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus - another occasion for penance, reparation, mortification and prayer. Masses in the Abbey Church will be at 6:00 A.M. and 8:00 A.M. If there is the slightest trace of self-will - the entire effort becomes a useless waste of time. We must pray for the grace to recognize the leprosy of self-will, and the grace to treat the leprosy when we do recognize it!
