Man has to turn back - the CONVERSIO! But the force of pride is so strong that the turning back is beyond the consideration of most men, and in too many instances, the force is to great even for those of very prayerful demeanor and disposition.. The pride of fallen man was - and is - in irreconcilable opposition to the Humility of Christ. Humility came face to face with pride the shock was inevitable. It resulted in the death of the Son of Man! The impact of the concussion was so cataclysmic that the after shock of it all continues to quake the entire world to this very day! and its vibrations have loosened all of the stones of the edifice of man: his social structure, his priorities, his attitudes, his RELIGION! The real cataclysm remains unspeakable, because the real cataclysm is taking place in the hearts and minds of those who were sent by God, Himself, to be the guardians of His unchangeable Truth. WITNESS THE RECENT APOLOGIES THAT HAVE BEEN MADE UNDER THE SHADOW OF THE CROSS OF CHRIST'S CRUCIFIXION, AND WITNESS, ALSO, WHO IT IS THAT BLASTS OUT THE APOLOGIES AND EXCUSES! Is this not objective reality at its very This is history! It is not fantasy! No man can find reason to apologize for the cause of, or make excuses for the attitude toward anyone who had anything to do with the Crucifixion of Jesus Christ! The after shock of the quake seems to be greater than the original quake! If permitted to proceed without question or opposition, the aftershock will most certainly mutilate - it will annihilate - it will wipe out the Almighty Creator's plan to keep salvation possible to man, the man whom He made in His own image and likeness. This must not be allowed to happen, even if it has to be carried out by a handful of valiant all battered and torn to pieces by the great Leviathan!

His Holy Rule:

"Listen, 0 my son, to the precepts of thy Master, and incline the ear of thy heart, and cheerfully receive and faithfully execute the admonitions of thy loving Father, that by the toil of obedience thou mayest return to Him from Whom by the sloth of disobedience thou hast gone away."
