2. Please pray for the Sick and Shut-ins of our Chapels.
3. Today is the Feast of the great St. Teresa of Avila. Her writings on the Spiritual Life are most important. We quoted from her in last week's Bulletin.
4. Wednesday, October 18, 2000 is the Feast of St. Luke. As you know he wrote one of the Four Gospels. We should pray to him and ask for his help in the getting the Gift of Knowledge. Knowledge, enough to understand the Mysteries of Scripture - Knowledge of the Gospel he, himself, wrote.

6. Sunday, November 4, 2000 is the First Sunday of November. Therefore, there will be no Mass in St. Pius V Chapel in Birmingham on that day.

8. Thursday, November 2, 2000 is ALL SOULS' DAY - - NOT a Holy Day of Obligation.
