It must not be forced or manufactured. Our children must not be forged into shape and into believing. It is very dangerous to try to forge the interior life - the interior spiritual life of our beloved children. If we do - THE TIME WILL COME - when they will tear themselves away from the chains that hold them in place. Our example must be good, it must be true and IT MUST BE FREE! Love has to be free or it is not love at all - it is slavery.
